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This store located at 776 Longmeadow Street was owned and operated by Charles L. Wood. It was built in 1805 by Calvin Burt and Stephen Cooley. From 1839 to 1848 it housed a post office and The Gold and Silver Thimble Shop. In 1848 Dimond Chandler established his first button factory here. The building eventually became a grocery store and currently is home to The Spa on the Green.
