

In 1902, George Sanford Doane and his wife Lucy Maria Cook established the Doane Orphanage at the corner of Longmeadow Street and Forest Glen Road.

In the 1910 Census, 24 children, ages 6 to 11, were residents of the Doane Orphanage with birthplaces including Massachusetts, Vermont, Ohio, Maine and Connecticut. In many cases brothers and sisters were paired together.
