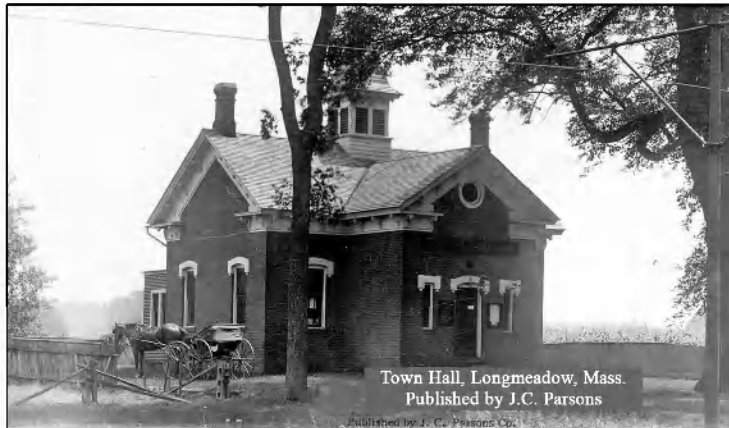


THROUGH THE LENS- LONGMEADOW 100 YEARS AGO

Given the horse drawn mode of transportation and trolley electric poles, the date of the postcard photo (left) is likely between 1906 and 1915.

Built as a school house in 1855, this building is the old North School. It was used as a school until 1906. It was then used as a Town Hall/ Police Station from 1906 until 1930 when the current Town Hall was built. It then became the headquarters of the Albert T. Wood Post 175/ American Legion.
